

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message *Alive Forevermore; Revelation 1:17-19*.

## Discussion Questions:

1. Have you had an experience of a “reveal” that was exciting or overwhelming?
2. Why is the book of Revelation called, “theology by picture”?
3. When John sees his old friend Jesus, what is his reaction? Why? What is Jesus’ reaction?
4. How does Jesus being “alive forevermore” give you hope when facing death?
5. What is the difference between knowing the facts about Jesus’ resurrection and knowing the power of it experientially? What has been your experience?
6. How does Jesus being ‘first and last’ offer hope when evil seems to be triumphing?
7. Where do you find it difficult to yield control to the Lord? Why?
8. What does it mean for Jesus to have the keys to death and Hades? What difference can this make in our lives?
9. Every eye will see him soon (1:7), how often do you think about the Lord’s return? How do you feel about it? If we really believed this, would we live differently?
10. Is there someone you’ve been hoping to share this news about Jesus with?
