5. Who is the hero of the Bible story? Where do you see this?
6. What kinds of trouble were the people in Psalm 107 in?
 - a. What did they do?
 - b. What did God do?
 - c. What were they to do next?
7. What is the [Night of Stories](#)? When is it? How does it connect with Psalm 107?
