

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message *The New Life, Romans 7:1-6*.

Discussion Questions:

1. What is the difference between justification and sanctification? (see [New City Catechism Q. 32](#))
2. How are Romans 6-8 similar to going through orientation at a new job or school?
3. If a new believer asked you, "What do I need in order to be a growing disciple?" how could you include what we learn in Romans 7:1-6?
4. Looking at Romans 6:1-7:6, what does it look like to be married to the law?
5. What is the Christian's relationship to the law?
6. What does it look like to be married to Christ?
7. How does this affect or change the way you think about what it means to be a Christian?
8. Good marriages are built on self-giving. What does Christ give to his people? What do you have to give to Christ?
9. How does marriage to Christ give you a new motivation to holiness?
10. How does marriage to Christ give you a new power to live a life of "gradual, growing righteousness?"
