

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message *What Can I Do for You?* Hebrews 10:24-25.

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Hebrews 10:19-25.
2. What did Randy say is the basis of our Christian faith? Where do we find it in our text? (the finished work of Jesus Christ). How is this also the basis of our life together?
3. How does realizing we are all forgiven by the finished work of Jesus help us to love others and accept them where they are? How does it motivate us to encourage others?
4. How do you need to be encouraged toward love and good deeds? And how are you uniquely gifted to spur others on to love and good deeds? Think about ways you can encourage the people in your life?
5. In what ways are you tempted to forsake assembling together? Do you agree with Randy, "the more difficult it is for us to be together, the more we need it?" What does this mean?
6. What does it mean to look in two directions at once? Why do we need younger people in the faith in our lives? Why do we need examples of older Christians in our lives? How did the illustration of Morty Lowenstein encourage Randy?
7. What changes do you need to make in your life to make sure you are assembling together regularly with other believers (and spurring them on!)?
