

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message *More Than Conquerors*; Romans 8:31-39.

Discussion Questions:

1. Read the text: Romans 8:30-39
2. Why do you think Paul asks questions of his readers? What is his goal?
3. What point do you think is being made by the question, "He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?"
4. How does what Jesus did, as described in verse 34, help us to fight condemnation and accusations when we feel like we don't measure up?
5. Have you ever felt uncertain of the love of God? When? What did it feel like?
6. How do verses 34-37 help us when we are uncertain of God's love?
7. Read verses 38-39. What gives us confidence to trust God, when we don't feel his love, in the midst of trials, and tribulations? What does the text say has the ability to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord? What does this imply? How can this be true?
8. Why is this truth so important to helping us in our walk with Christ?
9. Pray for God to help you right now in your place of need. Ask him to give you what you need in your journey right now - see verse 32!
