

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message "Our Father" from Matthew 6:9.

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Matthew 6:9-13.
2. When you think about God what comes to mind? Is it a blessing or troubling, easy or difficult for you to think of God as Father?
3. What do you think is the significance of Jesus addressing God as father?
4. How does praying to God the Father in heaven affect your prayer life?
5. The second part of verse 9 is, "hallowed be your name." What are we praying for when we pray this request?
6. What does Ezekiel 36:23-27 teach us about how God will cause His name to be acknowledged as holy in the world?
7. How does God invite us to be a part of making Himself known around the world?
8. In what ways do you feel called to pray for God's name to be hallowed around the world? Who, or what countries, would you like to pray for?
9. Take some time to pray for Japan, and Seita and Emma (and other Christians there).
10. Close by taking time to thank God that He is a holy, loving father who has made a way for you to be reconciled to Him through His Son!
