5. What are the implications for me if my passport is from the Kingdom of Heaven?
6. What are the obstacles I face that keep me from sincerely praying, "Your will be done"?
7. What's one step I can take to be vulnerable to obey God's will in my life?
8. How does the gospel make it possible to change from "my will be done" to "your will be done"?
