

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message "Forgive Us" from Matthew 6:12.

## Discussion Questions:

1. What are you learning about the Lord's Prayer? How is it a pattern for your prayers?
2. How would you say each of the lines of this prayer in your own words?
3. During our church's 40 days of prayer, what is one way you can stretch yourself in prayer?
4. Why is it so easy to underestimate sin? What strategies have you found to help you avoid this?
5. What are 5 things we learn about God from Exodus 34:6-7? How does Jesus fulfill these verses?
6. If God has already forgiven all your sin and you are justified before Him, why would you need to ask forgiveness again?
7. What is the difference between seeking pardon from an angry judge and seeking forgiveness from a grieved Father?
8. Why do you think Jesus emphasizes so strongly the need for Christians to forgive others? (See Matt. 6:12; 6:14-15; 18:21-35)?
9. How were you affected by Corrie ten Boom's story? How was she able to forgive the guard?
10. Where have you recently seen your need for forgiveness? To forgive someone else? How does the grace we find in the gospel make this possible?
