5. If your life is a house, what would it look like to give Jesus the key to every room?
6. What are the basic facts we must know about Jesus in order to be saved?
7. Where are you experiencing a growing desire for people to hear about Jesus?
8. How many times does Paul cite the Old Testament in Romans 10? What does this tell you about how your Bible is put together?
9. What can you learn about the character of God from 10:21?
10. Who are you praying for to confess Jesus as Lord? Who can pray with you for them?
