

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message "God's Unstoppable Plan" from Romans 11:1-16.

Discussion Questions:

1. How does our weekly experience of church differ from everything that happens during the rest of the week? How does it reorient us to eternity?
2. Why would God give us portions of His Word that are difficult to understand?
3. What is God's plan to bring salvation to the nations of the world? Where can you find evidence of this in Genesis 12, 15, & 17?
4. Romans 11:1-17 answers the question, "Has God rejected his people?" in two ways. What are they?
5. Where have you seen a gospel-centered life or church promote "jealousy" in someone, causing them to desire to know God in Christ?
6. Have you ever felt all alone in your faith? How could this passage help you?
7. What does this passage tell us about God's heart for the Jewish people? How does this affect you?
8. How does this passage give us confidence that God keeps His promises? What promises are you holding on to?
9. How does this passage lead us to worship God in His awesome saving power? How can we thank and praise Him now for what He has done?
