

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message "God's Tree" from Romans 11:17-36.

Discussion Questions:

1. What does it mean for God to be incomprehensible? Why can this lead us to worship rather than doubt?
2. What is the tree described in Romans 11:16-24? Who are the branches? Roots?
3. What reasons do Gentile Christians have to not be proud, but stand in awe (v. 20)?
4. What are some ways to express humility about your relationship with God?
5. What does Romans 11:26, "in this way all Israel will be saved" mean? How does the context help us understand how to interpret the "all"?
6. What do we learn from this passage about God's view of Jewish people?
7. How can each phrase in Paul's hymn (vv. 33-36) lead us to worship God?
8. What can you find in Romans 9-11 that leads you to praise God? In Romans 1-8?
9. What are five verses in Romans 1-11 that stir your heart and bring glory to God?
