

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message "Use Your Gifts" from Romans 12:3-8.

## Discussion Questions:

1. How does the gospel we believe intersect with our everyday lives? Why does it sometimes happen that what we sing about on Sundays doesn't make much of a difference on Mondays?
2. In Romans 12:1-2, what kind of a response does the mercy of God call for?
3. What does Romans 12:3-8 have to say about our new identities in Christ?
4. What does the culture we live in teach us about where to find our identity?
5. Romans 12:3-8 provide an illustration (v. 4), a principle (v. 5), and an application (v. 6). What are they?
6. Where have you seen Christians relating to one another as fellow members of the same body?
7. Why do some Christians believe some gifts have ceased and others believe they continue? What are your thoughts about this?
8. How can a Christian find out what her gifts are?
9. How do the gifts magnify Jesus?
10. How does the use of grace-gifts affect the lives of other believers?
