## Discussion Questions:

1. What expressions of love do you see around you in the church, community group, etc.?
2. What expressions of love are found in vv. 9-21?
3. There are several statements of how to express love that also include a negative - what not to do. What can you learn from each negative?
4. Which aspects of extending Christ-like love are most challenge you?
5. Think of someone you know who is in need. How can you serve them with the love of Christ?
6. Is there someone in your past or present who has done you harm? What wrong responses are you tempted to? What would it look like for you to overcome evil in that specific situation?
7. Do you need to seek counsel from a wise, mature Christian or counselor about how to deal with an issue or a wrong done to you?
8. In what practical ways can you love your enemies and do the good?
