

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message "The Five How's of Our Mission to the World" from Romans 10:14-15.

## Discussion Questions:

1. In the testimony we heard at the beginning of the message, what was it about Jesus that drew Kim to him?
2. How has God designed the gospel to be spread? Why do you think he chose to do it this way?
3. What do you find to be the biggest obstacles to talking about Jesus with other people?
4. What are the "how's" of Romans 10:14-15? Where do you see yourself in this picture?
5. In two minutes or less, what is the gospel?
6. Who are God's "sent ones"? Are you one?
7. How does Jesus, or the grace we receive through him, make it possible for us to be people who share good news with other people?
8. How does this time of year open up opportunities to connect with people we live and work and go to school with?
9. Is there someone you hope to invite to our Good Friday or Easter services?
