

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message "Three Resurrection Facts" from 1 Corinthians 15:1-11.

## Discussion Questions:

1. If you've never been to the moon, how sure can you be that people really landed there? How does this help us think about Jesus' resurrection?
2. In the sermon it was said that if Jesus hasn't really risen from the dead, Christianity collapses in a heap. Why?
3. What three facts about Jesus' resurrection do we find in 1 Cor. 15:1-11? How confident are you about them?
4. Why is Isaiah 53 (see especially verse 12) like a fireworks rocket that, when it goes off, shoots in many directions?
5. Who do we learn that Jesus appeared to? Why does this lend credibility to the fact of Jesus' resurrection?
6. Why does Paul's transition from persecutor to apostle lend credibility to the truthfulness of Jesus' resurrection?
7. "All Christian hope rests in Jesus' resurrection." How do you respond to this statement?
8. If Jesus has truly risen from the dead, what hope does this offer his people?
9. How could this passage help someone who has doubts about Christianity?
10. What does it look like to stand in the gospel of Jesus? Where do you need help to do this today?
