

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message "Put on Christ" from Romans 13:8-14.

## Discussion Questions:

1. How does Jesus' resurrection change the way we understand the time in which we live?
2. How does learning to drive help us understand learning how to live the Christian life? (see Rom. 12:1-2)
3. How do we know if what feels like love truly is? Where have you seen something described as love when it was really something else?
4. How does the gospel change the way we relate to our neighbors?
5. What are the 10 commandments (or at least 4 of them) doing here in the New Testament?
6. What are some ways you've seen Christians love their neighbors in inspiring ways?
7. How is the present age like night and the age to come like daytime?
8. What does it look like for you to put on Christ?
9. How does the grace we receive from God in the gospel change our desires from darkness to light?
10. How has this passage of Scripture equipped you to better live out the Christian life?
11. How can we put on Christ?
  - a. Sing
  - b. Remember your baptism
  - c. Read your Bible and find Christ
  - d. Share
  - e. Pray Jesus' prayer
  - f. Read the gospels
  - g. Read a Christ-exalting book
  - h. Ask God to fill you with the Spirit
  - i. Rehearse the gospel
