5. What are some disputable matters in your personal experience?
6. How are Christians called to relate to matters of clear command in Scripture?
7. How has your personal life and experience affected how you have applied the gospel to your personal convictions?
8. What areas would you like to think about and pursue deeper convictions on?
9. How do verses 10-12 affect your thoughts about judging others?
