

Below are discussion questions for you to consider related to today's message "Preaching Where Christ is Unknown" from Romans 15:14-21.

## Discussion Questions:

1. What do you hope to be remembered for when you die? Do you have any dreams or goals for your life?
2. What do we learn about God from this passage?
3. How does the unlikely conversion of Paul affect the way you think about what God might do through you?
4. What is amazing about God's gospel?
5. What is the difference between a country and the "nations" (ethne) that we heard about in Romans 15? (Check out the Joshua Project [website](#) for more information.)
6. If all Christians are faithful to reach out with the gospel to their friends and family and neighbors, will that eventually result in all the world hearing about Jesus? Why or why not?
7. How have you experienced the missionary heart of God?
8. What are some ways to grow in becoming more passionate about the people of the world who have never heard about Jesus?
