4. What can we learn from that about evangelistic strategy?
5. What can we learn from that about God's wisdom in delaying dreams and plans?
6. Where have you seen partnerships work to help advance the mission of the gospel? To extend mercy?
7. What dreams or plans do you have that are being delayed or rerouted? How are you responding?
8. Who can you strive for in prayer today?
9. How does grace create generosity in God's people? Where have you seen this?
10. How does the gospel bring people together in unexpected partnerships?
