

Below are discussion questions for you to consider related to today's message "The Rebellious Prophet" from Jonah 1:1-16.

Discussion Questions:

1. What has been your experience with Jonah?
2. Take 15 minutes to read through the book. What is it about? Is there more going on than it seemed at first?
3. What makes Jonah different from other prophetic books?
4. Why might Jonah have not wanted to preach to the Ninevites?
5. Who are groups we see as enemies or threats? What response comes naturally to us when we feel threatened? How is God's way different?
6. How are Christians called to live prophetically in our world?
7. Who is in the boat with us? Do you find yourself indifferent or unconcerned about people in storms? How does God's compassion offer hope for change?
8. What are three ways God's compassion come into view in this passage?
9. How does what we see of Jonah here direct our attention forward to Jesus?
10. Is God using this warning to speak to you in some way?
