

Below are discussion questions for you to consider related to today's message "The Angry Prophet and the Lord of Compassion" from Jonah 4:1-11.

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Jonah
2. When you see Jonah's anger, what do you think he is angry about? What makes you angry?
3. How does God oversee the details in Jonah's life and story? How does what happens to Jonah demonstrate God's love for Jonah? Can you see the sovereignty of God in the details of your life?
4. What is God's disposition toward Ninevah? What is surprising or perhaps different from what you might expect in this?
5. What is left undisclosed or unresolved at the end of the story? (How Jonah eventually responds to God's invitation) How does this point us to Jesus and call us to respond?
6. How is Jesus, 'one greater than Jonah'?
7. Randy said, "there is a Ninevah all around us and a Jonah in all of us." What do you think of this?
