

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message "Disciples Grow Together" from 1 Corinthians 12:12-27.

Discussion Questions:

1. Read the message text 1 Corinthians 12:12-27.
2. What is the context of this conversation (see verse 1 of the chapter)?
3. Who has spiritual gifts and what are they for (read 12:7)?
4. What metaphor does Paul employ in these verses to describe the church?
5. Why is verse 13 encouraging? How does it help you appreciate the body?
6. When you think of the gifts you have, which attitudes in verses 14-21 do you most often tend toward?
7. Do you feel like you need others? How do these verses describe our need for one another?
8. How have you ever given or received care in the body of Christ? Which was more difficult for you?
9. How are you investing your gifts in the body of Redeeming Grace Church? How can you grow in cultivating life giving relationships?
