## Discussion Questions:

1. Read John 1:1-18
2. What do we learn about the Word from verses 1-3? Describe the Word of God
3. Read verse 14 - what does it mean that "the Word dwelt among us"?
4. Read John 12:23. How is the cross an expression of God's glory?
5. Is Jesus life to you today? What would change in your life if you looked exclusively to Jesus for life?
6. What are places in the world that you are tempted to look for life instead of Jesus?
7. How do you think you should respond to these historical realities (the cross and resurrection)? Read John 1:11-13.
