

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message "What Is the Hope of Glory?" from Colossians 1:27.

Discussion Questions:

1. What is the glory of God?
2. J. I. Packer writes, "The to-and-for of seeing glory in God and giving glory to God is the true fulfillment of human nature at its heart, and it brings supreme joy to man just as it does to God (cf. Zephaniah 3:14-17)." - J. I. Packer, *Concise Theology*, p. 59
3. Have you experienced this kind of joy?
4. Looking at John 1:14 and Heb. 1:3, how do we see the glory of God in Christ?
5. If someone were to ask you, "Where is Jesus now?" What would you say? How does Colossians 1:27 influence your answer?
6. How can the believer know that Christ is really in him or her?
7. What is this glory we are hoping for? (see Rev. 21:11 & 22)
8. How does the hope of future glory affect the way we live now? (see Rom. 8:18) Where have you seen this in your life or the life of another disciple?
9. Is there a place of weakness, disappointment, suffering, or loss in your life that you can bring this hope of glory to?
