

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message "#2: Worship on God's Terms" from Exodus 20:4-6.

Discussion Questions:

1. What are the 10 Commandments? Can you recite them?
2. Why should Christians learn them?
3. What is the difference between the first commandment and the second?
4. Looking at Exodus 20:4-6
 - a. What is the command from God?
 - b. What is the reason?
 - c. What is the warning?
 - d. What is the promise?
5. Why is it encouraging to know that God is a jealous God?
6. Israel was on a journey from slavery in Egypt to the promised land. They were tested along the way when they didn't know what God was doing and why he was taking so long. How did they respond (Exodus 32:1-6)? How do Christians find themselves in parallel situations?
7. Looking at Colossians 1:15, Hebrews 1:3, and John 14:9, how does Jesus become for us a representation of God?
8. How does Commandment #2 instruct us about our worship services?
9. We all have a tendency to look to created things for identity and purpose. Where are you most likely to look? How does the second commandment help you reform your worship?
10. How do John 14:24 and 1 John 5:21 help us understand how the second commandment applies to Christians?
