

Below are follow up questions for you to consider related to today's message "#5: Family Priorities" from Exodus 20:12.

Discussion Questions:

1. What are the first four commandments? Can you recite them from memory?
2. Review of the fourth commandment:
 - Why did Christians shift their day of worship from the 7th day to the 1st day of the week?
 - How do you find rest for your soul in Christ?
 - How do you observe the Lord's Day? In what ways is it a delight? What obstacles do you find to gathering for worship on that day?
 - How and when do you rest physically?
3. What does it mean to honor your parents?
4. Why do we need this commandment?
5. How does destabilizing the family affect a society? What opportunities does this create for the church?
6. What can we learn from Jesus' example in Luke 2:49-52 about the first and fifth commandments?
7. What are the limits of honoring parents?
8. What does it look like in practical ways to honor your parents if you live at home? If you are grown? If they are aging?
