## Discussion Questions:

1. If the 10 commandments were part of the old covenant, and Christ has given us a new covenant, why shouldn't we ignore them completely?
2. Can you imagine a world without theft? What would be different?
3. Where do you see theft in our world today?
4. What does this commandment reveal about God's character? How does Job 41:11 help?
5. How does Ephesians 4:28 help us think about what C8 prohibits and what it requires?
6. How does C8 help us think about work?
7. How are you feeling about the coronavirus? How does Luke 12:22-35 transform the heart of a worried person?
8. Where have you seen yourself break C8, either in action or desire? Is there anything God is showing you that you need to confess or repent of? Or make restitution for?
9. How does Christ being crucified between two thieves offer hope to any C8 breaker?
