

John 13:34 – A new commandment I give to you, that you love **one another**: just as I have loved you, you also are to love **one another**.

John 13:35 - By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.

John 15:12 - This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.

<u>Romans 12:10</u> - Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor.

<u>Romans 12:16</u> - Live in harmony with **one another**. Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight.

<u>**Romans 14:13**</u> - Therefore let us not pass judgment on **one another** any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother.

Romans 15:7- Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God.

Romans 15:14 - I myself am satisfied about you, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able to instruct **one another**.

<u>Romans 16:16</u> - All the brothers send you greetings. Greet **one another** with a holy kiss.

<u>**1** Corinthians 12:25</u> - that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for **one another**.

<u>1</u> Corinthians 16:20 - All the brothers and sisters here send you greetings. Greet one another with a holy kiss.

<u>2 Corinthians 13:12</u> - Greet **one another** with a holy kiss.

<u>Galatians 5:13</u> - For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve **one another**.

<u>Galatians 6:1-2</u> - Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted. Bear **one another**'s burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

Ephesians 4:2 - ... with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love...

Ephesians 4:32 - Be kind to **one another**, tenderhearted, forgiving **one another**, as God in Christ forgave you.

Ephesians 5:19 - addressing **one another** in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart,

Ephesians 5:21 - submitting to **one another** out of reverence for Christ.

<u>Colossians 3:9</u> - Do not lie to **one another**, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices

<u>Colossians 3:13</u> - bearing with **one another** and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

<u>Colossians 3:16</u> - Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing **one another** in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

<u>**1** Thessalonians 5:11</u>- Therefore encourage **one another** and build **one another** up, just as you are doing.

<u>**Hebrews 3:13</u>** - But exhort **one another** every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.</u>

Hebrews 10:24 - And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,

<u>Hebrews 10:25</u> - not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging **one another**, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

James 4:11 - Do not speak evil against **one another**, brothers. The one who speaks against a brother or judges his brother, speaks evil against the law and judges the law. But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge.

James 5:9 - Do not grumble against **one another**, brothers, so that you may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing at the door.

James 5:16 - Therefore, confess your sins to **one another** and pray for **one another**, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

<u>**1** Peter 1:22</u> - Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love **one another** earnestly from a pure heart,

<u>1 Peter 4:9</u> - Show hospitality to **one another** without grumbling.

<u>**1** Peter 4:10</u> - As each has received a gift, use it to serve **one another**, as good stewards of God's varied grace.

<u>**1** Peter 5:5</u> – Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward **one another**, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."

<u>**1 Peter 5:14</u>** - Greet **one another** with the kiss of love. Peace to all of you who are in Christ.</u>

<u>1 John 1:7</u> - But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with **one another**, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.

<u>1 John 3:11</u> - For this is the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should love **one another.**

<u>1 John 3:23</u> - And this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and love **one another**, just as he has commanded us.

<u>**1**</u> John 4:7</u> - Beloved, let us love **one another**, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God.

<u>1 John 4:11</u>-Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love **one another**.

<u>**1** John 4:12</u> - No one has ever seen God; if we love **one another**, God abides in us and his love is perfected in us.

<u>**2** John 5</u> - And now I ask you, dear lady—not as though I were writing you a new commandment, but the one we have had from the beginning—that we love **one another**.
