2023 Sunday Teams Volunteer Fair

Thanks for being part of Redeeming Grace Church! Serving on one of these teams is a practical expression of being a disciple of Christ. Please consider serving on one of these teams as we partner to advance the gospel! Most Sunday teams serve on a once-per-month rotation unless otherwise noted. Training is provided for all positions; no experience necessary unless otherwise noted.

Bookstore

Members of the Bookstore Team serve on a rotating basis to help guests and members find and purchase books and other items on Sunday mornings, before and after the Sunday meeting.

Childcare Team

Team members provide childcare for Sunday morning events such as RGCU and Member Meetings. Volunteers are scheduled as needed depending on when events occur. There are also occasional childcare needs for events that take place outside of Sunday mornings.

Coffee Team

The Coffee Team serves starting at 8:45 AM on Sunday mornings by prepping the coffee and hot beverage service before each Sunday meeting. Teams prepare the beverages and supplies, provide assistance until the service begins, and clean up and restock for the following week.

Deaf / Hard of Hearing

Team members provide American Sign Language interpretation during the service for worship, announcements, and the sermon. ASL experience is necessary.

Grace Kids

Grace Kids is a teaching and outreach ministry serving children aged 1 year - 6th grade on Sunday mornings. Teachers and their helpers present Christ-centered, biblically based lessons that are reinforced by activities and crafts. Teachers serve for four weeks in a row, three times a year; helpers serve one week per month.

Lord's Supper Team

The Lord's Supper team prepares, serves, and cleans up the bread and the juice for the congregation each Sunday. The prep and clean-up team serves starting at 9:00 AM on Sunday mornings. Also, you can volunteer to help serve the Lord's Supper elements, which takes about ten minutes during the service after the sermon is preached.

Medical Team

Members of the medical team serve once per month by being on call during the Sunday service in case of a medical incident. Medical team members will provide first aid, call 911 in case of emergency, and document any medical incidents that occur.

Member Meetings

Every other month, our church holds an all-church member meeting that includes a church lunch immediately following the service. Volunteers serve once or twice per year by helping prepare the lunch, serve the lunch, and clean up after lunch. Meal plans and recipes will be provided.

Projection Team

This team serves during the Sunday meeting and other church events by displaying slides, videos, song lyrics, quotes, and other special presentations that require use of the projection screens. Team members serve on a rotating basis based on the number of team members.

Security Team

The Safety and Security Team seeks to glorify God and serve the local body of Redeeming Grace Church by providing a safe and orderly environment for worshipers. Both men and women are needed and previous security experience is helpful, but not required.

Sound Team

Members of the Sound Team use their technical gifts to provide balanced amplification of singing, preaching and announcements to form a foundation for the singing of God's praise and the preaching of His Word during Sunday services and other events in the life of the church.

Usher Team

The Usher Team arrives at 10 AM on Sunday mornings to greet guests, help with seating guests as needed, serve the Lord's Supper elements during the service, and assist with other administrative needs for Sunday meetings and special events.

Video Team

The Video Team serves by live streaming and recording the message portion of each Sunday service, as well as special classes, conferences, and events in the life of the church. No previous experience is needed. Team members follow clearly written instructions for the process.

Welcome Center Team

The Welcome Center Team greets each guest entering the building for the Sunday meeting and acquaints visitors with the church and church building. The team also serves guests and members by providing information about the church and church life. Each team serves once a month before and after the meeting.

Worship Team

Members of the Worship Ministry use their musical and spiritual gifts to provide a foundation for the singing of God's praise during corporate worship. To participate on this team, you must meet the team member qualifications and go through an audition process. Team members serve on a rotation basis.

Most of these teams are actively recruiting for new team members!
